



- At a time when India was shackled under colonial rule, one man dared to dream of cultural resurgence—not through protest, but through knowledge.
- A brilliant judge, legal reformer, and statesman, Sri V.
   Krishnaswamy lyer could have lived in comfort and fame.
   Instead, he chose to give away 90% of his wealth to revive India's soul.
- VK Iyer also founded the Venkataramana Ayurveda College in 1905 to perpetuate Indian medical Systems.
- In 1906, he founded Madras Sanskrit College—not just as an institution, but as a civilizational act. A lighthouse in the storm of colonial suppression.
- He also founded Indian Bank, because he knew true empowerment needs both economic and intellectual strength.
- Awarded the Kaiser-i-Hind medal, but he sought no titles only a future where India would remember its roots and rise again








## THE OLDEST LANGUAGE IS SPEAKING TO THE NEWEST FRONTIERS

- NASA has studied Sanskrit for its logical structure—it's been called the "most unambiguous language ever created."
- Rick Briggs, NASA researcher (1985):
  - "Natural languages are too imprecise for programming… Sanskrit, however, has a rich tradition of scientific and grammatical analysis."
- Sanskrit's context-free grammar (Panini's Ashtadhyayi) inspired early development in computational linguistics and AI.
- Used in machine translation models as a test language for linguistic precision
- Over 120+ global universities teach Sanskrit
- Research in cosmology, consciousness, and quantum theory increasingly cross-reference Vedic texts.





Ayurveda is not just a system of medicine.



#### The result?


- A generation unfamiliar with India's role in global knowledge traditions.

That is the purpose of the True Itihasa Project.

- A select group of 4–5 distinguished scholars, working with objectivity and intellectual rigor.




#### WHERE NUMBERS WERE BORN WISE

## WE'RE NOT TEACHING MATH. WE'RE REAWAKENING MEMORY.


- Developing courses based on ancient texts: Lilavati, Buddhi Vilasini,







